

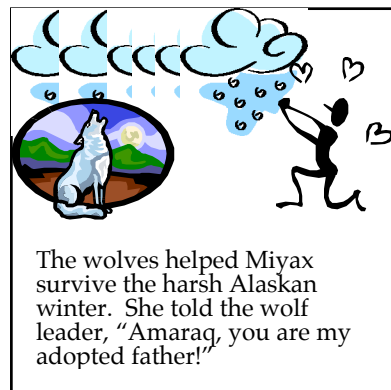
Comic Strip Book Report

Type of Book:

- your current classroom novel (“*Jar of Dreams*” or “*Dragonwings*”)

Book Report Requirements:

- **comic strip format**
- **must be 9 frames** (boxes) - no more, no fewer
(a final copy template will be available online)
- **must include a colorful picture and a caption/text** in *each* box
- yes, stick figures and clip art are permitted - the **text is the key thing** you’ll be graded for in this project, not your artistic ability. However, you’ll still need to be **creative**, and you’ll need both an **image** and an **explanation** in **every box**.
- examples are shown in the boxes below; other examples will be shown in class



Dates you need to know:

- **Project introduced in class June 1**
- **Final project due Friday, June 12**
- **Draft version due Wednesday, June 10**
- **Reading/work days: June 1-5 and June 8-11** You are expected to bring your novel and any other needed materials to class on these days.

Other important notes:

- If you finish your project early, **you are expected to come to class prepared** with independent work (silent reading, etc.) that will not distract those who will still need the time and quiet space to concentrate on their projects.
- This is a book report, so it is considered an at-home project. However, you are being given nearly two full weeks of class time to work on this project. Because of grading deadlines, **you may not turn in your project late** if you expect to receive credit for your book report. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**
- Even though we are all creating projects based upon one novel, each project should reflect *your* ability and *your* interpretation of the novel. In other words, **your work should be your own.** Please refer to Mount View’s Academic Integrity Policy if you have any questions.
